### **PURPOSE OF POSITION:**

Provide site support such as food services, logistics, housekeeping and administrative duties at Alaska Radar System (ARS) sites.

#### **PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Perform food services duties to include:
  - Safe food handling and storage practices.
  - Preparing meals.
  - Cleaning and sanitizing food preparation areas and dining rooms.
  - Inventorying and requisitioning food services items.
- 2. Perform housekeeping duties to include:
  - Cleaning restrooms and common areas.
  - Preparing temporary lodging rooms.
  - Managing site laundry requirements.
- 4. Perform site logistics requirements to include:
  - Tracking requisitions.
  - Breaking down and inventorying materials upon receipt.
  - Preparing material for shipment.
  - Documenting materials shipped including hazardous and dangerous goods documentation.
  - Maintaining logistics area in a neat, orderly and safe manner.
- 5. Perform site administrative duties, including maintaining Technical Orders and publications, down loading and distributing electronic communications, administering site visitor requirements, administering postal requirements.
- 6. Plan and coordinate work activities with other ARS personnel, sites, and departments.
- 7. Be familiar with ARCTEC Alaska publications, policies, and procedures, and the system, procedures, and equipment applicable to the job responsibilities.

#### **SECONDARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Observe and report weather conditions in accordance with military procedures at locations where required.
- 2. Act as Communications Security (COMSEC) Responsible Officer (CRO) or alternate CRO for the site COMSEC account.
- 3. Work cooperatively and constructively with customers, third party representatives and other company employees.
- 4. Maintain a safe and effective airfield environment for flying operations, to include conducting Bird Aircraft Strike Hazard (BASH) controls in accordance with applicable permits.
- 5. Assist in developing job related training programs and provide training as required.
- 6. Act as site monitor/administrator for all assigned test equipment in accordance with Operating Instructions (OI).
- 7. Notify the Operations Manager or Sector Lead concerning incidents and circumstances which could affect the performance of ARS mission systems.
- 8. Perform administrative duties and maintain assigned workplace, materials, and equipment in a safe, secure, and neat condition.
- 9. Perform other applicable duties as assigned.

#### **CORE QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Formal training or demonstrated ability in food handling and food services including menu planning and meal preparation for groups of 10 or more people;

OR

Formal training or demonstrated ability in the hospitality industry including hotel/motel management, catering, and organizing events.

- 2. Food handler's certification.
- 3. Ability to speak, read and write English proficiently enough to complete all employment duties.
- 4. Working knowledge of computers and typical applications including word processing (MS Word), spreadsheets (MS Excel), and database (MS Access).
- 5. Demonstrated ability in:
  - The military supply system.
  - Shipping materials using military or commercial air transportation.
  - Preparing, handling, and receiving materials.
- 6. Possession of a valid state vehicle operator's license.
- 7. Strong problem-solving and interpersonal skills to enable effective interaction with co-workers and customer representatives.

- 8. Strong organizational skills and the ability to work independently.
- 9. Knowledge of military Technical Order management.
- 10. Ability to obtain a final security clearance at the SECRET level.
- 11. Current biennial CPR and First Aid Certifications.
- 12. Ability to travel in small aircraft and be prepared to remain overnight in small villages in substandard accommodations.

#### **SECONDARY QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Ability to obtain a current military weather observer certification.
- 2. Certification or demonstrated competence in operating equipment required for logistics functions at the sites, such as forklifts and tool carriers configured for forklift operations.

## **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

The following physical activities are frequently required of a Station Technician: Balancing; bending; kneeling; squatting; reaching; standing; walking; climbing steep stairs; pushing; pulling; lifting heavy objects; grasping; communicating in person, by phone or through written correspondence; hearing; and seeing. Certain services technician duties may require repetitive motions. The noise level in the operating environment may require hearing protection.
